

Buyer Walk Thru Checklist

Upon arrival, cycle Appliances & Heating & Cooling Systems while you conduct the rest of the Walk Thru.

Appliances

- 1. Turn on dishwasher, let run (15 minutes)
- 2. Washer / Dryer to let them run their cycles (5 minutes to make sure belts work and function)

Heating & Cooling Systems

- 1. Test HVAC system by turning the thermostat up high and later low(seasonality may affect system)
- 2. Test all individual A/C and heating units work properly

Kitchen

- 1. Turn on / off the oven and microwave
- 2. Check vent and its associated lights
- 3. Turn on stovetop burners; smell for gas (make sure igniter works)
- 4. Check each kitchen cabinet, ensuring the hinges/drawers function / are aligned
- 5. Run water in sink to ensure water gets hot/cold
- 6. Test garbage disposal

<u>Bathroom</u>

- 1. Run water in all available faucets for hot and cold water, and water pressure
- 2. Flush all toilets
- 3. Check seals, caulking, knobs, door hinges, etc.

Electrical Outlets

- 1. Bring an outlet tester, phone charger, or night light to test outlets
- Test switches
- 3. Make sure all device plates are straight and installed tight to the walls
- 4. Ensure that light bulbs are installed in all appropriate fixtures and in working condition

Walls & Floors

- 1. Inspect hard wood or other flooring for stains, marks, any loose or broken boards
- 2. Check the walls for even paint, ensuring there are no dents, scratches, nicks, or discoloration

Doors, Windows, and Exterior

- 1. Make sure all doors open and close and doorknob handles function properly
- 2. Check that all windows open and close smoothly and are sealed properly
- 3. Open and close all doors, making sure they don't scrape the floor and that they close easily
- 4. Test the doorbell
- 5. Check the intercoms, concierge phone, and alarm system (if applicable)
